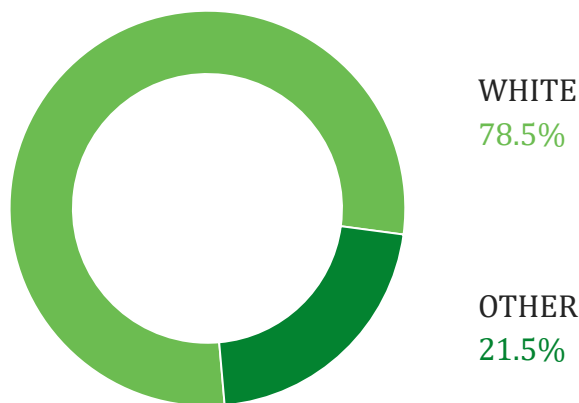

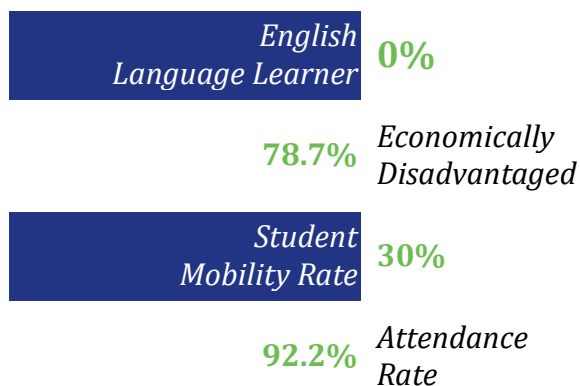


Student Demographics

Our Academic Goals

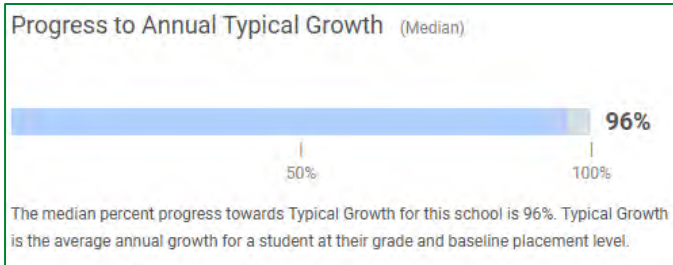
- By FY2026, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state English Language Arts tests will increase by **15%**.

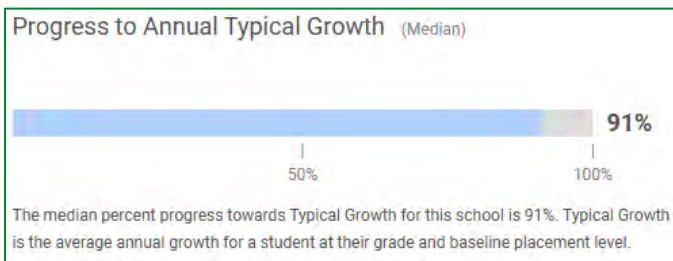

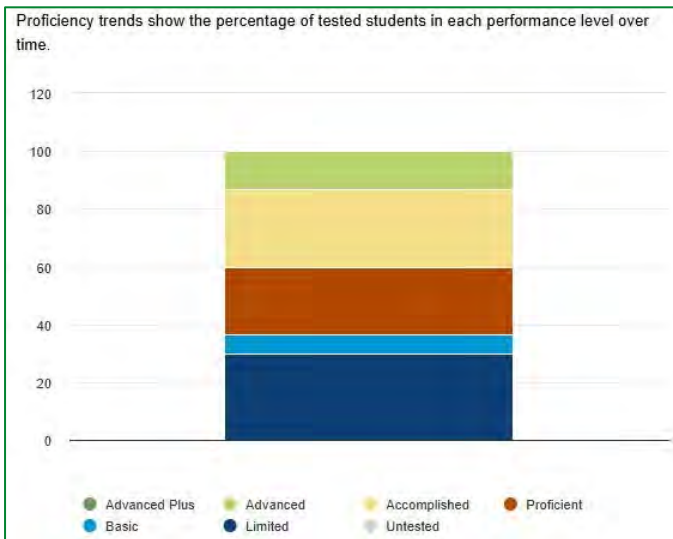
iReady Data Reading
